- 6. Who came to meet Bishan Singh in the asylum before the exchange of lunatics? What does Bishan Singh do when he is taken to the border for exchange of prisoners?
- 7. What are the reactions of the Anglo-Indian Lunatics on the occasion of Indian Independence?
